Illinois State University

Located in central Illinois in Normal Illinois is the campus of Illinois State University. ISU was founded on February 18, 1857 as the first public institution of higher education in Illinois. The founding father was Jessie Fell, and the founding legal documents were drafted by Abe Lincoln, establishing Illinois State Normal University. After more than a century as a single-purpose, teacher education institution, the 1960's brought change. These changes included the expansion of purpose to offer liberal arts as well as teacher education programs, introduction of doctorine level programs, and in 1964 renaming the institution to Illinois State University.

Now after more than 125 years ISU, who's first enrollment had 43 students, has expanded to above 20,000 students, and 1,300 faculty. Today ISU consits of five different colleges with 32 academic departments, and over 200 major fields of study.

Today ISU is committed to serve its students and the citezens of Illinois and the nation through the communication of knowledge, creation of knowledge, and application of knowledge. To do this ISU is dedicated to provide students with the finest possible education in Illinois.
