Editorial Forum


AT THE CLOSE of a remarkably successful Alumni Fund Drive, it is helpful to do some long range evaluation. The Alumni Fund first came into existence in 1945-46. It was the close of World War II, and reading from the November 1945 issue, "KDR today has approximately fifteen inactive chapters . . . we have no executive secretary. (The latter) is a big job, a tough job. But in all probability it is the only thing that will save Kappa Delta Rho from merging with another fraternity. If ever we needed the help of every Brother it is now."

Alumni dues were first levied on January 1, 1943 as a war-time source of income. Contributions were few and scattered. In 1946, approximately 136 alumni contributed dues . . . there was no total announced. By 1953 total amounts of slightly over \$2,000 were being collected and the fund had become the Loyalty Fund. Support was up to some 50 alumni per chapter among the leaders. Then came the Korean War and another period of problems and difficulties. In 1958 the *Quill & Scroll* had missed its mailing dates, the national office was down to one or two men and the fraternity was again on the brink of either merging or extinction.

Largely due to Brother Baughman, a renewed organization was formed which today is progressing firmly into a new future. The records of the Loyalty Fund and more recently, the Alumni Fund, show a surge which cannot be denied. There were other heros and tough decisions to make. They were made.

But it isn't all sweetness and light. While our alumni are doing more, and hopefully will continue to do more, the impact of inflation is reflected here as everywhere else in the United States today. How much of the total announced herein is comparable to the dollars of the 1960's, 1950's and 1940's? While there is undoubtedly more interest and greater participation, and while we are certain that the totals are an improvement in past performances, inflation does scale down the degree of gain. As Editor, I know that the costs of the magazine are spiralling. The smaller versions of the *Quill & Scroll* evident this past year are being produced at approximately the same costs as those of several years ago. Mailing rates have increased as I'm sure you all are aware. Paper has risen. Printing is more expensive. The same can be said of chapter services, travel expenses and salaries.

And so it is perhaps even more important than before to continue setting records year after year. Six years ago we gambled on the premise of a strong, medium-sized fraternity of 30 or more chapters. We're partway along the road to a successful completion of that goal. The end is not in sight yet, nor should it be. We may even have a few setbacks before reaching that magic number . . . (we're not looking for them, but with the troubled atmosphere on today's college campuses, it would be foolish to ignore the possibility of some difficulties). In fact, our record to date is even more remarkable considering the above. And so, in closing, let me make an appeal to all of you to continue the good work in 1971-72. The coupon to use is on this page. You will be receiving word of the kickoff of the next fund drive shortly. Respond to either these remarks or the official drive letter. Kappa Delta Rho has weathered many storms in your lifetimes, and with the loyalty and dedication of its alumni it has every possibility of continuing as a vital institution for young men far into the future. We thank you all.

762 Donors a Record Level in Participation

THE SUMMER ISSUE of the *Quill & Scroll* this year is devoted entirely to the Alumni Fund. The 1970/71 version set records in many categories. Ten chapters surpassed previous records in number of contributors, including Beta, Zeta, Eta, Theta, Iota, Kappa, Lambda, Psi, Alpha Alpha and Gamma Alpha. Beta broke her previous record of 91 (1958/59) with an all time high of 95. The same chapter raised the highest amount given (Beta in 1968/69 with \$802) by not only a substantial amount, but also broke the \$1,000 level for a chapter . . . a first for our fraternity. Actually, Eta missed this level by a scant \$32.00, also exceeding the highest previous amount given.

The evident success of the Alumni Fund is a heartening sign to the Board of Directors of the continuing interest of our members in the future of Kappa Delta Rho; and her recent growth is partially the result of alumni concern and contributions. We are well started on our journey to the number of chapters which will make us truly self-sustaining, and we have come a long, long way both in spirit and concrete results from the static days of the mid-fifties when we were a fraternity more in name than in togetherness. Needless to say, we have a long way to go and will require more sacrifices in the upcoming years, but you can read the optimistic trends in the statistics accompanying this article. □




