

WHERE DOES THE ALUMNI FUND COME FROM?

A COMPARISON of last year's fund contributors and this, will show a consistently high percentage of repeat donors. As a study in statistics I began to calibrate donors by graduation date, using a ten-year base. I won't guarantee that I counted every name, but at least 99.8% were included . . . the remainder were Honorary and could not be designated by year. Results were as follows:

1900-10	3	1941-50	95
1911-20	38	1951-60	157
1921-30	190	1961-70	160
1931-40	155	1971-74	25

Considering ages of the men involved, this is a remarkable performance indicating unity of purpose and across-the-board support of the national fraternity. The dip in the 1941-50 period is scarcely that when you consider that during World War II, all chapters were shutdown for varying periods of time, and the group of graduates therefore considerably less than other 10 year periods. The earlier years up to 1920 are gradually being thinned by retirement and entries in the Chapter Eternal. The only flaw in the picture is that less than 1/10th of our graduates are handling 100% of the load. To the others who have held back, why not make use of the coupon on the right? 15% ALUMNI FUND INCREASE: \$8,865.40

829 Donors a Record Level in Participation

WITH a 15% increase in total contributions the Alumni Fund for the sixth year in a row set a new record. This year 829 contributors gave \$8,865.40. The number of contributors was also at an all-time high with a 9% increase over last year's record of 762 contributors.

For the second time in eight years Illinois (Eta) alumni took top honors with \$1,097, from 83 alumni, while Cornell (Beta) followed with \$967. This is only the second time in the history of the fund that a chapter has exceeded the \$1,000 level. However, Beta chapter maintained first place for the eighth consecutive year with 87 donors. Indiana (Nu) with 69, Purdue (Theta) with 61 and Lafayette (Rho) with 53 were third, fourth, and fifth respectively.

Nu Chapter with contributions of \$721 and Rho Chapter with contributions of \$639 each moved up a space over last year's standings to third and

fifth respectively. Theta Chapter was in fourth place with contributions of \$642, slightly under their record level of a year ago.

The 1971-72 Fund also established records in several other categories. The average gift of \$10.70 set a new high and was almost three times larger than the average gift fourteen years ago when the first fiscal fund was started. Eleven chapters, namely Gamma, Epsilon, Eta, Iota, Kappa, Mu, Nu, Psi, Omega, Alpha Alpha and Gamma Alpha set new records with the current number of donors exceeding their previous records.

Alumni Fund receipts have become an important source of income for the National Fraternity. The active support of many members of the Board this past year was reflected in the record number of contributors. The continued support of all members of the Board will be essential to the success of this year's campaign. □
