# Contributions to Annual Alumni Fund set record for the seventh consecutive year!!

TOTAL RECEIPTS of \$9,338.75 represented a 5½% increase over last year and the first time in the history of the Annual Alumni Fund that total contributions have exceeded \$9,000. 856 members and friends were contributors this year representing a 3½% increase over last year's record of 829.

Beta Chapter (Cornell) again led in both number of contributors and dollars contributed with 93 and \$1,192.50 respectively, after having relinquished the lead in dollars contributed to Eta Chapter (Illinois) last year. The contributions, in total, received this year from Beta represents the seventh time in nine years that the chapter has led the National and the first time that any chapter has contributed more than \$1,100. This record is a fitting tribute to Beta's Sixtieth Anniversary this year.

Theta Chapter (Purdue) moved from fourth to second place with 80 contributors. Indiana (Nu) with 75, Illinois (Eta) with 71 and Penn State (Zeta) with 69 were third, fourth, and fifth respectively. Theta Chapter, Nu Chapter and Zeta Chapter set new records this year in the area of total number of contributors while Beta Chapter was three contributions shy of breaking their record and a National chapter record of 95 contributors achieved in the 1970-71 Annual Alumni Fund.

With total contributions off slightly from last year, Eta Chapter fell to second place with \$994.50 contributed. Theta Chapter with \$895.00 recaptured third place and Nu Chapter fell to fourth place with \$701.00. Total contributions of \$633.00 put Zeta Chapter in fifth place after a record setting 35% increase in dollars contributed in one year, without a special solicitation.

Besides setting records in number of contributors and dollars contributed, the 1972-1973 Fund also established several additional records. The average gift of \$10.91 set a new high and was almost three times larger than the average gift fifteen years ago. A recent publication of another fraternity indicated that their average gift was under \$10 and that they had received contributions from less than 5% of their alumni while we have received good support this year from almost 9% of our living alumni. Eleven chapters, namely Zeta, Theta, Kappa, Nu, Omicron, Xi, Sigma, Tau, Omega, Delta Alpha and Epsilon Alpha set new records with the current number of donors exceeding or equaling their previous records.

The outstanding results achieved by Xi Chapter this year with 39 alumni contributing \$499.00 when compared with \$258.00 received from 29 alumni last year bears special recognition. As was reported previously a special appeal letter was sent to all alumni of the chapter and was followed by a personal letter sent by the directors. The results indicate that this personalized approach to this chapter was successful this year.

The receipts from the Annual Alumni Fund have become an important source of income for the National Fraternity. Moreover, through the Alumni Fund our members have found a method by which they are able to demonstrate support for an organization that played a meaningful role in their undergraduate lives. With this increasing support the National Fraternity will be able to expand the services which it is offering to today's undergraduate. Thus, our alumni will have the satisfaction of knowing that what was so important to them as undergraduates, namely Kappa Delta Rho, is being continued for our present undergraduate members. The on-going support of all members of the Fraternity and the members of the Board of Directors especially, will be essential to the success of the 1973-74 campaign. As one who has been affiliated with the National for some 15 years, it is useless to paint a completely soothing picture. There are problems . . . and there will always be problems . . . but Kappa Delta Rho has sustained many major crises in its history, and will continue to face the unexpected in the future, with your help and perseverance. Just as the Alumni Fund has helped provide us with a way to better accommodate ourselves to the challenges of the future, so we can see a small trend toward a more concrete foundation. Nothing can come without the involvement of all members,

both alumni and undergraduates. Continued progress demands continued dedication. About the only somber note in this past year's record performance of the Fund is the fact that we are still under 10% of our total living members in participation. This is lightened to a degree by the fact that this is better than it had been and better than many other similar organizations. But just think what we could do if everyone chipped in! This year we had 224 brothers who gave, who did not give last year. Also, there were 197 who gave last year who did not give this year. Last year their contributions totaled \$1,771.00. Had they contributed the same amount which they gave last year, we would have had a total of \$11,109.75 and 1053 Contributors! Think about it in 1973—74!



